Ponies

- Class J1 **Nursery** (13.2hh and under, rider 10 years and under) no BSJA reg. ponies
Jumps not to exceed 50cm in first round - can include lead rein
- Class J2 **12.2hh and under** (rider 12 years and under) no BSJA reg. ponies
Jumps not to exceed 60cm in first round
- Class J3 **Novice** (14.2hh and under, riders 16 years and under)
Jumps not to exceed 70 cm in first round. Combination not to have won a total of £50 ever.
- Class J4 **Intermediate** (14.2hh and under, rider 16 years and under)
Jumps not to exceed 80cm in first round. Combination not to have won a total of £100 ever.
- Class J5 **Open** (14.2hh and under, rider 16 years and under)
Jumps approximately 90cm in the first round.

Not before 12.30pm

Horses

All horse jumping classes, horse exceeding 14.2hh, rider any age.

- Class J6 **Pre-Novice**
Horses entered in this class will not be eligible for classes J8 or J9
Jumps not to exceed 60cm in first round. Combination not to have won a total of £40 ever.
- Class J7 **Novice**
Horses entered in this class will not be eligible to enter class 9
Jumps not exceeding 75cm in the first round. Combination not to have won a total of £50 ever.
- Class J8 **Intermediate**
Jumps not exceeding 90cm in the first round. Combinations not to have won a total of £100 ever.
- Class J9 **Open Horse**

- Class S1 Best Turned Pony
- Class S2 Best Conditioned Horse or Pony, any age, in hand
- Class S3 Mountain and Moorland, pure bred and registered, any age, in hand
- Class S4 Coloured, Horse or Pony, in hand
- Class S5 Young stock, in hand, under 4 years
- Class S6 Novice Ridden Pony – Includes lead rein.
(Competitor not to have won a first in any ridden showing class)
- Class S7 Best Ridden Pony
- Class S8 Working Hunter Pony - Special rosette for best M and M.

Other Showing not before 1pm

- Class S9 Best Turned Out Horse
- Class S10 Mountain Moorland, ridden - pure and part bred, Large and Small Pony 4 years and over, rider any age but should 'fit' pony
- Class S11 Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony 16 years and over.
- Class S12 Ridden Colored Horse or Pony
- Class S13 Novice Ridden Horse/Hunter – To be shown in a snaffle only
(Competitor not to have won a first in any ridden showing class)
- Class S14 Best Ridden Horse/Hunter
- Class S15 Working Hunter

Show Rules

Anyone not complying with these rules or any other reasonable request made by a Committee Member may be asked to leave the field

1. Child's age taken on 1st January 2011.
2. Hard hats to the current BSI standard to be worn at all times when mounted and securely fastened. Jackets to be worn when in the showing or jumping ring unless otherwise advised; long hair must be securely tied back. Suitable clothing and footwear must be worn when mounted anywhere on the Showfield.
3. BSJA rule apply to the show jumping, except that we allow two refusals before elimination.
4. Objections to be handed to the Secretary with a £15 deposit, which is forfeited should the objection not be sustained.
5. No entry is refundable.
6. The Judge's decision is to be accepted as final.
7. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, property animals etc., or for any accident or theft arising out of these Shows.
8. The Organisers reserve the right to vary the amount of prize money awarded or to amalgamate or cancel any class, according to the number of entries.
